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## Full-Time Firefighter/AEMT Recruitment

The Edgerton Fire Department (EFD) is currently seeking candidates for the positions of full-time Firefighter/AEMT. This recruitment is for both immediate opening(s) and to establish an eligibility list for potential future openings. We are looking for energetic personnel to help a growing Department expand to two, then three, and potentially four stations providing a high level of fire, rescue, emergency medical, public education, and inspection services to a growing number of communities.

The Edgerton Fire Department is a combination department made up of full-time, part-time, paid-on-call, paid-on-premises, and intern members which is expanding to serve 220 sq. miles covering 11 municipalities across Rock, Dane and Jefferson counties including the cities of Edgerton and Milton and surrounding Towns with a population exceeding 25,000. The Department covers 19.7 miles of Interstate 39/90 and portions of Lake Koshkonong and the Rock, Yahara, Badfish and Koshkonong waterways. The EFD provides a full range of paramedic-level 9-1-1 response, inter-facility transfer, structure fire, haz-mat, transportation fire, wildland fire, MABAS, water/ice rescue, crash, and rescue responses. The Department expects an average 7+ calls per day with yearly run volumes exceeding 2600.

Depending on qualifications, certifications, and prior experience the starting wage for Firefighter- AEMT positions is \$47,237 to \$59,455, with increases at 1-year, 2-years, 3-years, and 5-years. The Department will consider lateral transfers of up to 4-years municipal service. Positions may be 48/96 shift or 42-hr per week based on assignment at multiple stations.

### Requirements:

- US Citizen, and a minimum age of 18 years old with a high school diploma or equivalent.
- A valid Driver's License and good driving record.
- Pass a pre-employment background check, and NFPA 1582 physical.
- Minimum of Wisconsin State Certified Firefighter II, MPO, Aerial, and AEMT, or willingness to obtain such during probationary period.

### The Department offers a total salary and benefit package including:

- Wisconsin Retirement System.
- Wisconsin ETF insurance with the potential of 100% district-paid coverage based on plan selected.
- Paid holidays, vacation, comp time, and sick leave.
- Initial uniform and annual uniform allowance.
